Gentlemen:

This letter agreement cancels and supersedes our proposal to you on this same subject dated November 17, 1969.

Company proposes to establish the classification of Gas Technician in General Construction, with the following weekly wage rates:

2405 Gas Technician	Start	\$197.60
	End 6 Mos.	\$202.60
	End 1 Yr.	\$207.70

The duties of this proposed classification will closely parallel those of the Gas Control Technician in the Division Gas Departments with less emphasis on electronics. Normal progression to this classification will be from Oxygen-Acetylene Welder or Gas Mechanic.

Company further proposes to establish the classification of:

2404 Lead Gas Technician	\$216.05 per week
------------------------------------	-------------------

to be used on a temporary basis only when a Gas Technician is assigned to supervise the work of other Gas Technicians or the work of a crew consisting of three or more men, including himself, when such crew is engaged in work directly related to the work of a Gas Technician.

The following employees are currently engaged in work which would be considered that of Gas Technician and Company proposes the following:

Employees in the classifications of Subforeman A, Working Foreman A, and Working Foreman B, would retain their present classification and wage rate. Included in this group are Mr. L. Aaker, Subforeman A; Mr. R. Middlebrook, Working Foreman A; Mr. J. Lacy, Working Foreman B; and Mr. A. H. Boles, Working Foreman B.

Mr. D. R. Andrews, Mr. Harold Bush, Mr. John F. Camacho, and Mr. Ray Boyle are presently classified as Working Foreman C and are engaged in this

activity. Company proposes that these employees remain as Working Foreman C and in the event that any one of the four qualifies for Lead Gas Technician, he shall be considered as being in the line of progression to such classification.

Mr. Milton Krugh and Mr. Joe Fogel, Oxy-Acetylene Welders, will be reclassified to Gas Technicians at starting rate.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
