Gentlemen:

Effective June 1, 1959, Company proposes to modify the Lines of Progression for the Gas Transmission and Distribution Department found on page 12 of Exhibit VI by adding a footnote as follows:

> "6. Light Crew Foremen shall accrue classification seniority in the Fitter classification for bidding to Mechanic."

The purpose of this change is to permit Light Crew Foremen to be considered as Fitters and, therefore, in the next lower classification to Mechanic. This change will conform the Gas Department procedure to that of the Electric Overhead Department relating to Sub-Foreman, Lineman and Troubleman.
