Gentlemen:

For reasons as hereinbelow listed, Company proposes that Wage Schedule III, \$60.80 per week, for First Operators at Wise Power House be discontinued and that Wage Schedule II, \$64.40 per week, become effective in lieu thereof, as of May 1, 1947.

The responsibilities of the Operators at Wise Power House have been increased through the discontinuance of the Attendant at Grass Valley Substation and the transfer of service calls from the Grass Valley area to the Power House, and further responsibility will be added when the Canal and Halsey Power House alarms are extended to Wise.

If the Union is in accord with the above proposal it is desired that its acceptance be indicated on the duplicate copy of this letter in order that a record be made of such agreement pending formal execution of a contract thereon.
