Gentlemen:

The Company's new Rock Creek Power Plant now under construction in De Sabla Division is scheduled for operation early in the year of 1950.

With respect to the operating personnel the Company proposes that the classifications of First Operator and Second Operator be adopted for use at the new plant and that the wage rates therefor be the same as the wage rates for identical classifications now in effect for Caribou and other comparable plants.

Adoption of the foregoing proposal will necessitate that additions to the applicable Wage Schedule, effective March 1, 1949, be made as follows under the captions noted:
