The Utilityman classification at Alta, presently occupied by Mr. A. E. Bishop, will be eliminated on or before November 1, 1963.

Under Section 206.1(e) of the Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. Bishop in the Auburn Warehouse and to continue him in the classification and wage rate (\$135.35 per week) that he now holds. Since his present wage rate is above that of Storekeeper, it is proposed that he will be used for any type of warehouse work up to and including Storekeeper. From the date he commences work at Auburn, it is further proposed that he accrue classification seniority as Warehouseman. Forty percent of all previous time worked as Utilityman will be credited as time worked in the Warehouseman classification.
