Company will eliminate the Foreman's Clerk position in the Hydro Generating Department at Auburn and establish a new position of First Hydro Clerk in its stead.

Company proposes to reclassify Mr. T. E. Warwick from his present classification of Foreman's Clerk (\$129.50 - \$142.25 per week) to First Hydro Clerk (\$129.50 - \$142.25 per week) without reference to the bidding procedure. Mr. Warwick's classification seniority date will be July 1, 1963, the date that the proposed classification was first established. Mr. Warwick will be continued at his present rate of \$142.25 per week.
