Gentlemen:

The Company is changing the headquarters for a Collector classification from the Pittsburg office to the Antioch office. We propose to transfer the incumbent, Mr. E. O. Parmley, to the position at the Antioch office pursuant to the provisions of Section 18.17. We further propose that, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in Title 19, the employee shall have a right only to return to the Pittsburg office in the event that a Collector classification is later re-established there.

The proposed relocation of Mr. Parmley under these terms has been discussed with your Representatives, Mr. P. R. Dutton and Mr. J. J. Wilder, and it is understood that they are in agreement with the proposal.
