Gentlemen:

By letter agreement, dated October 8, 1968, Company and Union agreed to certain special conditions applicable to employees hired following a special training program under the auspices of the Management Council for Bay Area Opportunity. This agreement was subsequently extended from its expiration date of June 30, 1969 to June 30, 1970.

During the year beginning July 1, 1970, and ending June 30, 1971, Company plans to hire 45 hard-core unemployed individuals - 25 in San Francisco Division, six in the Marin and Napa-Vallejo Districts of North Bay Division, and 14 in San Jose Division. We propose to apply the terms of the letter agreement of October 8, 1968 to these employees, and to extend the term of that agreement by one year.
