Concurrently, Company will establish three Ditch Tender positions at Volta Powerhouse.

Under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, Company proposes to reclassify the employees in the three Ditch Patrolman jobs to Ditch Tender at Volta Powerhouse, such reclassification to be effective one week after agreement is reached between Company and Union on this matter.

Company further proposes that for wage purposes, time worked in the Ditch Patrolman classification be considered as time worked in the Ditch Tender classification.
