Gentlemen:

Company has been unable to find technically qualified employees who want to stay in the Needles-Topock area.

Company proposes, under the provisions of Section 205.19 of the Agreement, to reclassify Mr. Carlos Castillo from his present classification of Plant Mechanic at \$189.70 per week to the classification of Apprentice Gas Control Mechanic at the top rate of \$179.60 per week, without reference to the bidding procedure. Mr. Castillo will not be eligible for automatic progression to unassigned journeyman until he has completed all of the requirements outlined in the Guidelines for the Apprentice Gas Control Mechanic Training Program under the Master Apprenticeship Agreement.
