Gentlemen:

As a result of recent discussions, Company proposes that for purposes of Title 205 previous time spent in any of the classifications of Flume Repairman, Pipefitter, Apprentice Flume Repairman, Apprentice Pipefitter, Blacksmith, and Rough Carpenter will be considered as time worked in the classification of Water Systems Repairman.

Likewise, time worked in the classifications of Subforeman (Pipe) and Subforeman (Flume) will be considered as time worked in the classification of Water Systems Subforeman.

In addition, Ditch Tenders on the Western Canal who were reclassified to Canal Maintenceman as a result of the September 29, 1967 letter agreement will have time worked as Ditch Tender on the Western Canal considered as time worked in the Canal Maintenceman classification.

It is further proposed that the above considerations be effective on August 1, 1970.
