Gentlemen:

Mr. Robert Bullock, Sr. and Mr. Harry Farrington, Electricians (red circle) in the Electric T and D Department in San Francisco, have been performing duties that fall within the job definition of a Senior Meterman classification. These duties include all types of meter, meter device and instrument transformer removals and replacements. Therefore, Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Bullock and Mr. Farrington to Senior Meterman without reference to the bidding procedure.

Such reclassification shall be with the understanding that Mr. Bullock and Mr. Farrington cannot transfer or progress in the normal line of progression until they have demonstrated that they can satisfactorily perform all the duties of a Senior Meterman.
