Gentlemen:

It is expected that commencing June 1, 1953 it will be necessary for Company to have one First Operator on duty at its new Pittsburg Steam Plant Switching Station. The station will go into operation shortly thereafter and more First Operators will be added. Ultimately such station will be comparable to the Contra Costa Steam Plant Switching Station and require both First and Second Operators.

Company therefore proposes to establish the classification of First Operator at Pittsburg Steam Plant Switching Station with a wage rate of \$86.60 per week and the classification of Second Operator at Pittsburg Steam Plant Switching Station with a wage rate of \$78.75 per week, both effective June 1, 1953.
