Gentlemen:

Company proposes to transfer 14 field garage employees now in the Gas, Hydro and Line Departments of General Construction to the General Construction Services Department.

Within the provisions of Title 306 of the Agreement, the Field Garage Mechanics, under this proposal, would have demotion rights covering all of the positions in their own group throughout General Construction rather than demotion rights among the smaller groups now part of the three constructing departments.

The employees involved in this transfer shall continue to be field employees and, even if assigned temporarily to work in the Davis Shop, will be subject to the expense allowances and other working conditions of field employees.

Names, classifications, seniority dates, present locations, etc., of employees affected have previously been given to Mr. L. L. Mitchell.
