Company proposes to establish the classification of Utility Pressure Operator at the San Jose Division Load Center with the following Job Definition and wage rates:

Utility Pressure Operator - San Jose

An employee who is an Emergency Relief Pressure Operator and, in addition, may be assigned clerical duties of the Operation Supervisor's Office including the checking of charts and the calculation of volumes for all types of gas measurement. May be assigned to perform routine repair work on meters, regulators and instruments.

Proposed Wage Rates

Start	- \$133.20 per week
End 6 Mos.	- \$137.45 per week
End 1 Year	- \$139.80 per week

It is further proposed that time worked in the Utility Pressure Operator classification will be considered as time worked in the Pressure Operator classification.
