Gentlemen:

With the conversion of Halsey Powerhouse to automatic operation the services of a full time Station Attendant will no longer be needed at such location. Therefore, Company proposes to reclassify this position, currently held by Mr. Kenneth McKenzie, to Utility Station Attendant at the wage rate of \$91.35 per week. (NO INCREASE OVER FORMER JOB - Roving ATTENDANT SAME HEADQUARTERS)

The proposed job definition for this classification is as follows:

Utility Station Attendant - Halsey Powerhouse

A resident employee who is engaged in operating Halsey, Dutch Flat and Alta Powerhouses as required and may act as Day off Relief Operator at Wise Powerhouse during vacations. In addition he shall perform such routine maintenance at these and other locations as greasing turbines, patrolling penstocks, checking and charging batteries, and checking and making minor repairs to automatic equipment used in the operation of these Powerhouses and their related water system.

This employee will accrue classification seniority as a Station Attendant.
