Gentlemen:

This letter agreement replaces a proposed letter agreement dated January 4, 1963, which was cancelled by correspondence dated February 26, 1963.

Company now proposes to eliminate the classification of Machinist in the Sacramento Garage and establish the position of Lead Mechanic at that location. Company further proposes to place Mr. E. A. Pendell in the position of Lead Mechanic (\$145.95 per week) without reference to the bidding procedure. Mr. Pendell presently holds the classification of Machinist (\$145.95 per week) which is to be eliminated.

Company further proposes this reclassification be effective on June 8, 1964.
