As agreed during the 1970 general negotiations, Company will change, effective December 18, 1970, the Night Fitter in Oakland to Gas Repairman.

Company proposes, under the provisions of Sections 206.13 and 205.19 of the Agreement, to place the present incumbent, Mr. W. Harris, into the Gas Repairman position without reference to the bidding procedure. Company further proposes that for as long as Mr. Harris retains his welding skills he shall be considered as a Fitter for purposes of job bidding under the provisions of Title 205 of the Agreement.
