Gentlemen:

Pay practices in General Construction have been changed, as Company and Union agreed in the 1970 General Negotiations, to provide a payday every two weeks.

Inadvertently the language of Title 304 of the Physical Agreement was not changed to reflect this previous agreement.

Therefore, Company proposes to amend Section 304.3 of the Physical Agreement to read as follows:

304.3 Wages shall be paid at biweekly intervals on Fridays for a two (2) weeks' payroll period ending not less than four (4) nor more than ten (10) days prior to the pay date provided that if the regular pay date falls on a holiday payment shall be made on the preceding work day.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
