Gentlemen:

Installation of additional facilities and associated equipment at San Mateo Substation in San Jose Division will require that the station be manned twenty-four hours a day. Company therefore proposes that effective September 1, 1953, the following classification be established for this location and included in the schedule of wage rates:

OPERATOR, FIRST

San Jose Division
Station: San Mateo . . . \$86.60

Four First Operators and one Emergency Relief First Operator will be required to operate the station. The wage rate of \$86.60 per week is proposed in contemplation of the installation of additional equipment within the next few months, which on completion will make this station a switching center.
