LABOR AGREEMENT INTERPRETATION

SUBJECT: Six-Hour Rest Period

TITLE 208 - OVERTIME - Physical Agreement
Title 308 - " " "
Subsection 208.11(b) AND 308.14(b) *RTW*

The above Subsection shall mean:

All hours worked at the overtime rate, as provided for in Subsection (a), in the 16-hour period immediately preceding the beginning of the employee's regular work hours on a work day shall be included to determine entitlement to a rest period. When the employee has taken a rest period of six consecutive hours after fulfilling the requirement provided for in Section 208.11, those hours worked prior to the rest period shall not be counted again to determine another rest period.
