As a result of recently completed negotiations with respect to job definitions and lines of progression in the Division and General Office Building Departments, Company proposes to discontinue the classification of Finish Carpenter and to establish the following classifications and wage rates:

End 18 months	100.40 " "

Company further proposes to change the title of the Building Subforeman classification in the General Office to Building Maintenance Subforeman with no change in wage rate and to change the title of the Building Subforeman in San Francisco and East Bay Divisions to Building Service Subforeman in San Francisco and Sacramento Divisions.

Company further proposes to delete the limitation to General
