Gentlemen:

Company will eliminate the classification of Ditch Patrolman at Ross Reservoir in Stockton Division.

Concurrently, Company will establish the classification of Ditch Tender at Angels Camp.

Under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Bruce R. Child from Ditch Patrolman at Ross Reservoir to Ditch Tender at Angels Camp, such reclassification to be effective one week after agreement is reached on this matter. Company further proposes that, for wage purposes, time worked by Mr. Child in the Ditch Patrolman classification be considered as time worked in the Ditch Tender classification.
