Our proposed letter agreement dated October 13, 1959 is hereby withdrawn.

In accordance with our recent discussions on this subject, Company proposes to amend the lines of progression of the Electric Maintenance Department by adding the following:

"4. An employee in the Apprentice Communication Technician or Apprentice Electrical Technician classification who was formerly classified as an Electrician may bid back to such former classification as an Electrician and time spent as an Apprentice Technician shall accrue in the Electrician classification for bidding to Electrician."
