Gentlemen:

Company has recently reviewed the lines of progression in the Water Department. As the result of this review, Company proposes that the footnote applicable to the Water Meter Repairman be modified to provide that a Water Meter Repairman who has completed the apprenticeship for the Pipe Fitter classification may accrue classification seniority as an Apprentice Pipe Fitter for bidding to Pipe Fitter and to provide that a Water Meter Repairman who has not completed such apprenticeship would have to do so before being considered as being in the next lower classification to Pipe Fitter.

The present line of progression gives no credit in the Apprentice Pipe Fitter classification to a Water Meter Repairman who has completed this classification and tends to make the Water Meter Repairman a dead-end job.
