Company proposes to establish the classification of Utility Carpenter at Auburn. For payroll purposes, this classification will be in the Division Transportation and Stores Department; however, for bidding purposes, the classification shall be considered as being in the Building Maintenance Department. The following is the proposed Job Description and wage rate:

Utility Carpenter

An employee who is a Carpenter and, in addition, may be assigned the repair and replacing of tool handles and the repair and refinishing of pike poles and ladders. He must be familiar with all types of live-line tools.

The employee in this classification shall accrue classification as Carpenter in the Building Maintenance Department.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.


