Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter of January 25, 1977, on the same subject.

Over the last several years, numerous letter agreements, pursuant to Subsection 302.7(e)(2), have been concluded between the Manager of Industrial Relations and the Union Business Manager concerning changing the hours of work of various General Construction crews. The reason for these requests is generally the request of the employees to expedite commuting and entails moving either the starting time or quitting time one-half hour.

Pursuant to Subsection 302.7(e), Company proposes that changes in hours of work of one hour or less for the various General Construction Department crews at the request of the involved employees be concluded between the General Construction Personnel Manager and the Union Business Representative serving General Construction.

This letter agreement may be canceled by either party upon giving the other party a 30-day written notice of such cancellation.
