Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter to you of April 13, 1977, on the same subject.

Since October 1, 1975, Mr. Robert L. Rodgers has been on Long Term Disability. Mr. Rodgers had been, prior to this time, an Electrician in the General Construction Station Department. He has also been a Field Clerk in General Construction.

He has, at the present time, recovered to the degree that he has been released for certain work. During the past year, he has been working with the State of Washington's Department of Vocational Rehabilitation; and after extensive medical evaluation, this department has recommended that he be considered for semi-skilled work not involving complex mental tasks.

Consequently, Company proposes to establish a Utility Transformer Repairman classification in Santa Rosa and assign Mr. Rodgers to this position pursuant to Section 112.15 of the Physical Agreement.

2150 Utility Transformer Repairman

Performs the duties of a Transformer Repairman and, in addition, performs material handling activities such as the shipping and receiving of transformers and tools, maintenance of the tool room including the dispensing of tools and making ID underground tags, and other routine duties. May be required to use material handling equipment.

Wage Rate: Start - \$251.25
End 6 mos. - 260.55
End 1 yr. - 270.80
