## Gentlemen:

To improve the use of manpower at the Pipe Line Operations operating facility in Milpitas, Company intends to eliminate the third shift for Terminal Operators at the facility. In conjunction with this change, Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement to change the hours of the first shift to 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM and to 2:00 PM to 10:00 PM for the second shift.

Company further proposes the adoption of a 21 -day rotating schedule for Terminal Operators which will provide a Terminal Operator on each first and second shift with an extra man on the first shift each Thursday. This schedule provides for four regular days off (Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday), seven second shifts, two regular days off (Tuesday and Wednesday), and eight first shifts. This schedule is identical to the one in effect for Terminal Operators at Antioch. A copy of this rotation is attached.
