Gentlemen:

The above-named employees were subpoenaed by the National Labor Relations Board to testify at a hearing in Santa Maria on September 12, 1978. They were not parties to the action before the Board. Their purpose was to testify as to their functions as Shop Stewards at Morro Bay. Their compulsory attendance prevented their working that day, and pursuant to Section 101.11, they would not be entitled to pay.

In the light of the circumstances described above, but without setting a precedent for future instances of a like or similar nature, the Company believes that it would be inequitable for the employees to suffer a wage loss and, therefore, propose to pay them eight hours straight-time pay and per diem (if applicable) for that day.

All other expenses incurred by the employees are to be borne by them.
