On May 10, 1977, agreement was reached to return Mr. R. L. Rodgers from the long term disability payroll to a newly established Utility Transformer Repairman classification in Santa Rosa, in accordance with Section 112.15 of the Physical Labor Agreement. Mr. Rodgers has worked in this classification since June 6, 1977, and has submitted prebids to an Apprentice Electrician's classification in North Bay Division.

Mr. Rodgers was awarded, under the provisions of Subsection 205.8(b) of the Agreement, an Apprentice Electrician job in San Rafael on January 8, 1979, in error inasmuch as the Utility Transformer Repairman classification does not show as next lower in the line of progression to the Apprentice Electrician classification. Therefore, Company proposes at this time, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Agreement, to place Mr. Rodgers in the Apprentice Electrician classification. Prior to Mr. Rodgers' placement on long term disability, he was an Electrician in the General Construction Department.
