Gentlemen:

Company is in the process of changing the volume of pipe presently wrapped at the Decoto pipe yard, and as a result, the volume has been declining at a consistent rate, which will necessitate the displacement of Harley Gene Blandford, Plant Maintenance (1180), to another headquarters. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Labor Agreement, to transfer the Plant Maintenance classification presently held by Mr. Blandford to the Emeryville shops and revise the job definition accordingly:

1180 PLANT MAINTENANCEMAN

A qualified employee who performs all types of repair and preventive maintenance work on all yard and shop machinery and buildings operated by the Materials Distribution Department. Inspects facilities to determine work necessary. Must be proficient in the use of bench, hand, power and air tools and welding equipment necessary for such work. Shall also perform minor electrical repair work.
