## Gentlemen:

Mr. James C. Dawson, Senior Meter/Regulator Mechanic, Gas Meter Repair Plant, suffered an industrial back injury April 16, 1971, and has a permanent limitation not to lift anything over 75 pounds. As a result of the recently negotiated revisions to the Job Definitions, Gas Meter Repair Plant, Mr. Dawson is precluded from performing the full duties of his new classification.

Company intends to restrict Mr. Dawson's job duties within his classification to provide functional guidance and quality assurance checks of other employees' work. It is therefore proposed, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Labor Agreement, to establish regular hours of work for Mr. Dawson of 11:00 AM to 7:30 PM, with a half-hour lunch period, in order for Mr. Dawson to practicably perform these job functions.

It is our understanding that the Business Representative serving this area concurs with this proposal.
