Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to change the hours of work of 34 employees in Pipe Line Operations at the following locations:

1. Hinkley Compressor Station - employees in Technical Maintenance, Transmission Maintenance, Materials and Garage.
2. McDonald Island - all day employees in the Underground Storage Section.

The new hours are to be from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with the lunch period from 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The inclusive dates for this schedule are to be from the first week in June to the first week in September. The agreement will be self-renewing unless canceled by either party upon giving 30 days' written notice to the other of such cancellation. This arrangement is similar to the one presently in effect at the Topock Compressor Station.

It is our understanding that this proposal has been discussed with the Business Representative serving Pipe Line Operations and has his concurrence.
