Gentlemen:

Company proposes to reclassify Fulton and Ignacio Substations in North Bay Division from Schedule II to Schedule I.

The wage rates of the four First Operators - Schedule II at each of the stations will be increased from \$148.85 per week to \$155.30 per week, the wage rate of First Operator - Schedule I. The wage rates of the Emergency Relief First Operators - Schedule II at each of these stations will be increased from \$151.85 per week to \$158.30 per week, the wage rate of Emergency Relief First Operator - Schedule I.

Company further proposes these reclassifications be effective the date agreement is reached on this matter.
