Gentlemen:

On or about August 5, 1962, the Morro Bay Switching Station will become operative and the manning of San Luis Obispo Substation will be discontinued.

Company proposes to establish the classification of First Operator, Schedule II, at Morro Bay Switching Station at a wage rate of \$131.40 per week (\$136.90 per week under the pending agreement).

Company further proposes to fill the five First Operator jobs and, in addition, the classification of Electrician/Emergency Relief First Operator at Morro Bay Switching Station with the employees holding identical classifications at San Luis Obispo Substation without reference to the bidding procedure.
