Gentlemen:

It has become necessary for the Company to station employees at the MacDonald Island Storage Field on a seven-day, three-shift basis. Company proposes to establish the classification of Storage Well Operator in the Gas Department for employees assigned to the MacDonald Island Field. The proposed job definition and wage rate are as follows:

Storage Well Operator A shift employee whe operates gas storage wells and related equipment. He shall perform such work as turning wells on, shutting wells in, observing flow rates and pressures, blowing scrubbers, operating valves on gathering line systems, adjusting the rate of injection and withdrawal in accordance with established Company procedures and other routine maintenance and operating duties. Wage rate: \$105.95 per week.

The proposed rate includes the five and one-half percent general wage increase effective July 1, 1959. It is proposed that there be no next lower classification to Storage Well Operator, but that the classification be filled on the basis of Company seniority and qualifications in accordance with the Agreement. It is further proposed that the classification of Storage Well Operator be considered as next lower to Pressure Operator in Stockton Division.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
