Gentlemen:

Company has recently completed a survey of the duties assigned to the Utilityman classification in the Gas Department at Fairfield currently held by Mr. E. J. Mohr. The basis of the present rate of \$98.95 per week is 50% Serviceman and 50% Warehouseman.

As a result of the reorganization of certain work within the district, the Warehouseman portion of the job will be reduced to 20% or less. Company, therefore, proposes to reclassify this Utilityman classification to Utility Serviceman with the following job definition:

<u> Utility Serviceman - Gas Department - Fairfield</u>

An employee who performs the work of a Serviceman in the Gas Service Department and, in addition, performs all of the work and duties relating to the operation of the Fairfield Substore.

This employee will receive the wage rate of and accrue classification seniority as a Serviceman in the Gas Service Department.
