During the period that Mr. Latham has been on light duty, he has relieved the Utility Foreman's Clerk in the Burney Commercial office. The regular Utility Foreman's Clerk has been off for a considerable period of time and is scheduled to retire on May 1, 1980.

Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Labor Agreement, to place Mr. Latham in the Utility Foreman's Clerk position, Burney. At this time there are no Division bidders for the job and the local Business Representative serving the area is in concurrence with the proposal.
