Re: Wage Progression - Certain Instrumentation Technicians

Reference is made to our previous Letter Agreement establishing the classification of Instrumentation Technician and the placement of certain individuals therein at various wage levels. At the time, the placement of individuals in diverse wage steps was made arbitrarily. Since then, experience indicates that certain of these employees are performing at a higher level than originally anticipated and others are not performing up to their anticipated levels.
