Gentlemen:

Mr. Harley G. Blandford, Plant Maintenceman (1180) headquartered at Emeryville, was displaced from the Decoto Pipe Yard by Letter Agreement dated April 24, 1979, as a result of the declining demand for pipe wrapping activities at the Pipe Yard. At this time, the Decoto Pipe Yard has re-evaluated their needs and have determined that a dramatic increase in pipe wrapping has occurred over the last few months; and Mr. Blandford has been temporarily assigned to take care of this need. It is anticipated that this higher level of activity is permanent and will necessitate the classification being returned to the Decoto Pipe Yard.

Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Labor Agreement, to transfer the Plant Maintenceman classification presently held by Mr. Blandford back to the Decoto Pipe Yard re-establishing the Plant Maintenceman classification and job definition. It is our understanding that Mr. Blandford lives in Southern Alameda County and is in favor of the move. Further, the Local Business Representative serving Materials Distribution is aware of the move and has his concurrence.
