He was returned to work in 1979 as a Temporary Additional Light Truck Driver as part of a Rehabilitation Program; and as a result, proved successful in this classification. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Mager permanently into a Light Truck Driver's classification, General Service Department, San Rafael, North Bay Division.
