Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes our proposed Letter Agreement dated June 12, 1980 (previously numbered 80-45-PGE).

The Apprenticeship Committee met recently to discuss an East Bay grievance concerning the award of an Apprentice Fitter job. During the review of the case an interest, on the part of the Union, was expressed to change the Company's job award procedure, as it applies to this classification.

Currently, the Company awards Apprentice Fitter jobs so the employee will be sent to the Primary Apprentice Fitter School not more than two weeks following such an award. In some cases, the employee is awarded the job effective the first day of school.

Company proposes to change its procedure as follows:

Job awards to the Apprentice Fitter classification shall be made "Pending" when a vacancy, which Company intends to fill, occurs. The job will be awarded by bid to the Senior qualified employee having a valid prebid on file. The employee will not report to the classification sooner than two weeks preceding the next available Primany class.
