Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes our proposed Letter Agreement Dated November 8, 1979 (your file No. 79-122-PGE).

The current Building Technician classification, General Office Building Department, is restricted to an incumbent-only position and as a result of the Building Department's increasing technical work, including the installation of the computerized Energy Management System scheduled for 1980, the Company proposes, pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement, to reestablish this classification with the following job definition and wage rate:

2355 BUILDING TECHNICIAN

An employee who, without direct supervision, adjusts, maintains and repairs building electronic, hydronic and pneumatic equipment. May assist in developing or modifying devices used in the building operation. May be required to perform the duties of Lead Building Mechanic and Lead Building Engineer. May be delegated to assign work among employees in other classifications and furnish them with functional guidance in the performance of such work. Must have qualifications including demonstrated proficiency/ability in working with Electrical, Electronic, Mechanical, Hydronic, and pneumatic equipment.

Note 1: May be assigned regular hours of work pursuant to Section 202.15 including the standard shifts of 7-3, 3-11, and 11-7. When more than one shift is utilized at a headquarters, the shifts may be assigned on either a rotational or non-rotational basis. It is not the intent to change any practices relative to the rotation of shifts in effect on the effective date of this agreement without the prior agreement of the Union.
