Gentlemen:

Ms. Debra Sylvester, Helper, Gas T&D Department, Sacramento Division, suffered an industrial back injury on May 5, 1980 that precludes her from performing the duties of her regular classification. Ms. Sylvester has formerly held the classifications of Helper, Electric Maintenance, Transformer Repairman, and Apprentice Electrical Machinist in Sacramento Division and is currently being considered for a Shop Meterman vacancy in Sacramento. In view of her electrical background, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, to place Ms. Sylvester in the Shop Meterman classification at the beginning step of that classification.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. A. E. Sandoval, the Union Business Representative serving Sacramento Division and has his concurrence.
