Gentlemen:

Mr. Jerry W. Meyers is a T&D Driver headquartered in the Electric T&D Department in Petaluma. He is 37 years old and has close to 12 years' Company Service. On October 5, 1980, while at the two-year wage step as an Apprentice Lineman, he suffered a lost-time industrial injury when he fell from a pole and broke his foot.

It was later determined by Dr. G. T. Schantz, Company Panel Physician, that Mr. Meyers' injuries precluded any further pole climbing associated with his work assignments, and he was placed into the T&D Driver position on August 24, 1981.

An Inspector's position in Vallejo has recently become vacant, and in his new position Mr. Meyers is no longer eligible to prebid to this classification. Mr. Meyers resides in Sonoma and has requested consideration to this job. There was only one prebidder and he has declined a job offer.

Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Meyers into the Inspector's position in Vallejo.

This proposal has been discussed with IBEW Business Representative Frank Hutchins and has his concurrence.
