Gentlemen:

Mr. Steven J. McDaniel, Miscellaneous Equipment Operator B, General Construction, suffered an industrial injury to his right wrist on December 13, 1979 which precludes him from performing the duties of his regular classification.

On February 27, 1980, Mr. McDaniel went on the Compensation Payroll and remained until March 2, 1981 at which time he was returned to the Building Services Department (Garage) in General Office as a temporary additional Materialsman on the Rehabilitation Payroll. Mr. McDaniel has satisfactorily performed the work assigned to him; and after evaluating that work, it was determined that Parts Clerk more accurately reflects the work performed.

Your concurrence is requested to appoint Mr. McDaniels to this classification pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement. Further, based on current medical reports, Mr. McDaniels has a permanent 30 pound wright restriction which may preclude him from consideration for bidding or transferring to other physical classifications or Parts Clerk in other locations unless he becomes fully recovered at some time in the future.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. Frank Saxsenmeier, Union Business Representative, and based on the information he has been provided, he concurs.
