
Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement and 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, that employees in the General Office Building Services Department (specifically Mail Clerk Drivers and 2nd and 3rd shift clerical employees) and Division Pony Express Drivers (i.e., Light Truck Drivers) be given Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve off in lieu of the floating holidays they would otherwise receive on Christmas Day, December 25, 1981 and New Year's Day, January 1, 1981 (holidays on non-work days). This would give them two 3-day weekends, and avoid dispatching drivers on each respective Sunday (12-27-81 and 1-3-82) without any mail.
