Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement and the Apprenticeship Committee Settlement of San Francisco Division Grievance No. 2-529-80-87, Company proposes to establish a Utilityman position in the General Office Building Department with the following Job Description and Rate of Pay:

Utilityman - General Office Building Department

An employee who is engaged in the performance of maintenance work, including but not limited to, repair of building equipment and accessories, office fixtures and furniture, electrical outlets, light switches and fixtures, plumbing fixtures, windows, floors, minor painting and furniture moving. May use hand and power tools for which he has been trained and has demonstrated his ability. May work alone or may assist other classifications.

Wage rate - \$400.20 per week

Mr. Daniel Pizarro will be reclassified to the Utilityman position on the effective date of this agreement and paid at the appropriate equivalent rate retroactive to the date of his demotion from Building Mechanic to Helper.


