Gentlemen:

The Gas Construction Department's Mechanical Services Group currently has several lubrication ("lube") crews which travel from job site to job site to service construction vehicles and equipment. These crews normally consist of one Field Garage Mechanic C and one Field Garageman. Because these crews remain at each job site for only brief periods of time, they are assigned under the provisions of Section 301.9 of the Physical Agreement. However, it is cumbersome, if not impossible, to return the employees in these crews to their headquarters within the required 30-day limit as specified in Section 301.9.

In order to relieve the above difficulties, and to facilitate production and administration of the Agreement, Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 301.9(c), to include these "lube" crews in the special provisions of Subsection 301.9, along with the Station Communication Instrumentation and Protection Groups and the Gas Instrumentation and Control Groups.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
